Organization

- Is the presentation organized in a way that is understandable and clear?
- Is there a clear development of ideas?
- Does the presentation consider chronological development?

Information

- Does the presentation convey information which educates the class on the theme of Ancient Egypt?
- Are important terms and concepts defined and explained in the presentation?
- Has the British Museum website on Ancient Egypt been well researched?
- Are the two extra website resources visible somewhere in the presentation (such as at the end of the powerpoint presentation?)

Presentation Quality

- Are the visuals for the presentation relevant, visible and helpful to the presentation?
- Is the oration of the presenters clear and understandable? Do they present too quick? Too slow?
- Do both partners present material to the class?
- Do presenters display eye contact with the audience or interact with class?
- Does the presentation last between 7-8 minutes?

You are allowed to use note cards or a script during the presentation, but be sure to not get too lost in the notes and maintain some facetime with your audience.
